Its purchase by the banker Sir Francis Child, founder of Child & Co, now owned by the National Trust

Sir Francis's grandsons employed Scottish architect Robert Adam, the most fashionable architects in Britain, in front of The Admiralty, Whitehall (1760) ; and the interior of Syon House interior, Brentford (1762–1769).

The Child family made their money by owning part of the East India Company. It was Nationalised but many Indian treasures lie within the House.
